### ONE DAY NATIONAL CONFERENCE REPORT.

#### **OUTCOMES:**

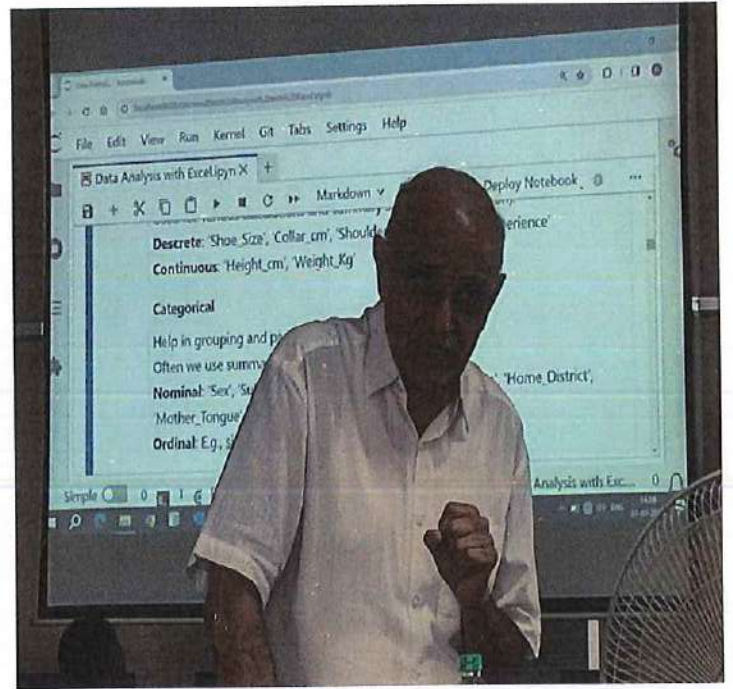
1. Participants have acquired a comprehensive understanding of AI and ML concepts, tools and algorithms.

Overall it was a remarkable FDP and positive feedback was obtained.

  
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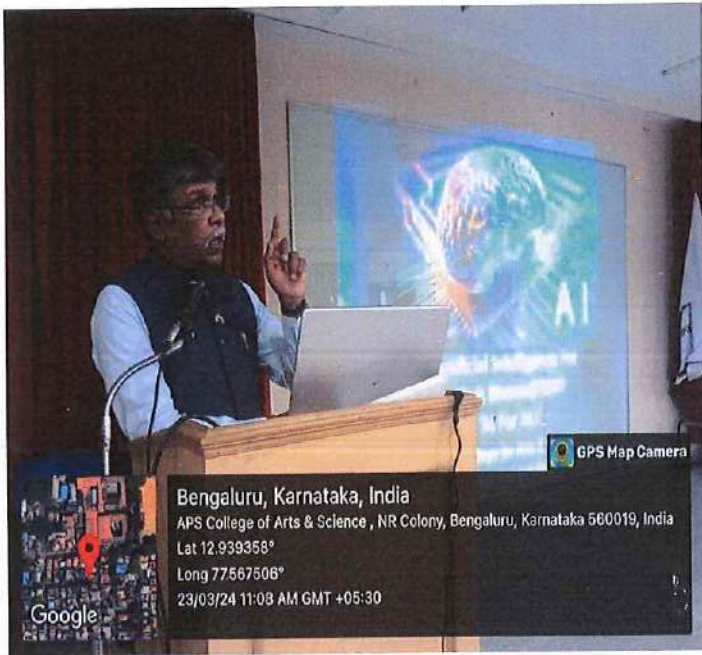
