REPORT ON WORLD MENSTRUAL HYGIENE DAY

The Women Empowerment Cell and Health Club of APS College of Arts and Science in collaboration with Campus Konnect (Brand Touch and Analytics Pvt.Ltd), organized a comprehensive soft skills and Hygiene training session dedicated to girl students on the occasion of Menstrual Hygiene Day on May 30th, 2024. - The program Inspired individuals to contribute positively to the nation.


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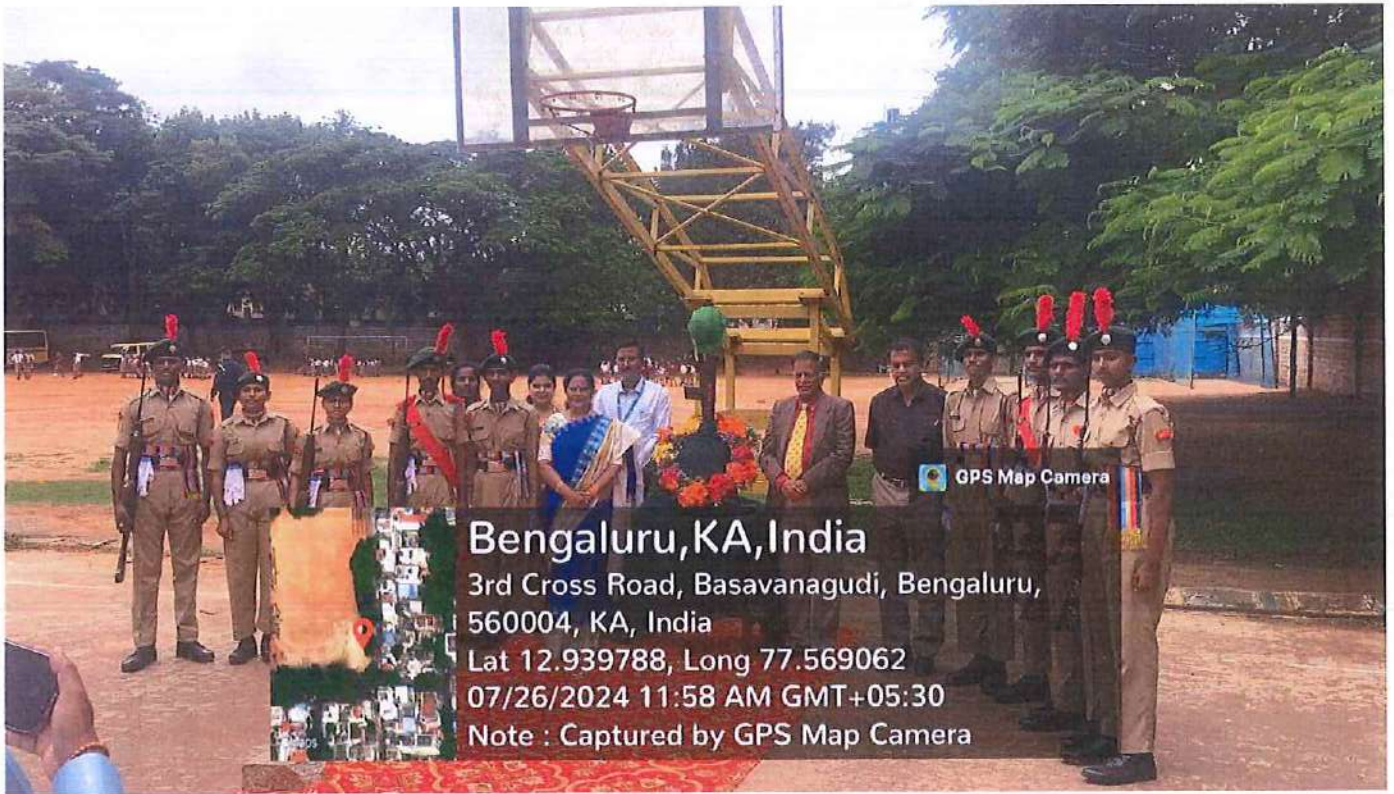
