


Rathasapthami celebration on 16^{th} February 2024 and International Yoga day on 21^{st} June 2024 was organized by NCC and NSS Unit.

"Kargil Vijay Diwas" was also celebrated on 26th July 2024 by NCC Unit.







Achievements of Students:

- Our Cricket Team won the Inter College Cricket Championship on 8th December 2023.


